At this point in 1915, they were able to invest in the group of cottages formerly known as 'Rose Cottages' and now known as 1 and 2 'Rose Cottages', 'Ivy Cottage', 'Holly Cottage' and 'Home Cottage'.

Untenanted – Holly Cottage [236]

Mrs Amos – Home Cottage [238]

In Kelly's Directory for 1925, Mrs Hurst is listed as living in Home Cottage.
