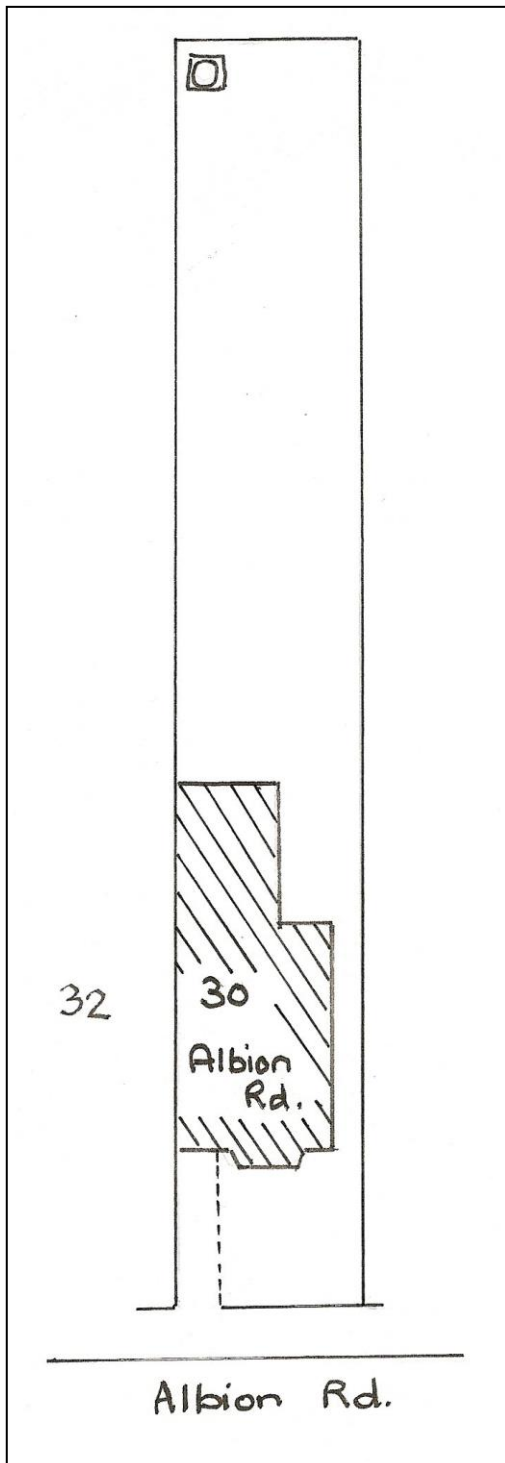


BOTTLE-SHAPED HOLE at 30 Albion Rd

Plan & diagram of the 'hole' found at the end of the garden at 30 Albion Road, Birchington. The hole is bottle-shaped and 3 feet across at the opening, widening out to 6 feet at the bottom of the 22 feet shaft. There are several pipes leading into the opening near the top of the shaft. A new brick wall has been built round the opening, butting onto the original old brickwork below. This then gives way to chalk-cut sides the rest of the way down.
