FURTHER INFO ON THE ABOVE CHILDREN

WILLIAM 1815 married Susanna Marsh born 1818 in Minster Kent, on the 23/10/1856, they had one child Susanna who was born and died on the 03/06/1858 at 12 hours old.

William was a master baker employing one man and one boy, in the 1858 Melville and Co Directory and Gazette William is stated as being the baker in Birchington, after 1858 when his brother Thomas and Thomas's wife Eliza died, William took in and raised three orphaned children as his own, one of them becoming a baker like him.

Susanna died and was interred on the 26/08/1865 in All Saints, Birchington, Kent.

The 1871 census shows William married to Ann living with Frederick and Ellen at the Bakers Shop, High Street, William is shown on this census as a master gardener this may not be the same William as unable as yet to find a second marriage. In 1881 William and Ann are visiting the Thorp family as there is a marriage between William and Ann Thorp in 1866 this may be correct, William is a florist.

HENRY 1818 married Hannah Impett born in Preston Kent, at St. Mary Magdalene Church in Monkton, Kent on the 12/10/1844. They had five children. Henry was a market gardener of 2 acres.

The above girls are the only two of Henry and Hannah's children registered as being christened at All Saints Birchington or St Mary's Monkton, this may be because they changed their religion and became non-conformists.

George W 1851

Eliza Jane 1854

Florence Meria 1857. she married Charles Ararna. (this name may be misspelt 1851 In Birchington with Hannah (wife) and children Mary Ann, Hannah Impett and George William.

1861 Unable to trace the family.

1871 census Henry and Hannah George their son was in the Navy as an ordinary seaman, their daughter Elizabeth/Eliza Jane was a domestic servant, and (Florence/Fanny)Meria was a scholar 1881 With wife Hannah and daughter Fanny and granddaughter Victoria (daughter of Eliza) living Canterbury Road Birchington.

1882 Hannah (wife) died in the December quarter aged 66.

1891 Living with his daughter Fanny in Birchington he is a widower aged 72.

MARY ANN married William Hewett in 1864.

1871 Living in Birchington with Ada aged 5 and Annie aged 5 months.

1881 They are living in Hopkin Cottage Dartford Kent, William is an ag. Labourer, with Annie aged 10 Gertrude age 8 and Henry 6

1891 William is shown still living with a Mary Ann in Margate, but it appears to be a second marriage, reasons being 1) she is a year older than him and born in Margate 2) William has three stepchildren Thomas James, Edith and William Jordon.

This William and Mary Ann have a son Archibald William aged 2 months born 1891, by 1901 they also have a son Joseph born 1893. There is a marriage in the March quarter of 1891 between William Hewett and Mary Ann Jordan BMD 2a 1257. As yet I am unable to find a death for Mary Ann nee Goodbourn.

HANNAH IMPETT GOODBOURN

1871 Hannah is a servant to Maria Neame in Birchington.

GEORGE no further trace as yet after 1871.

ELIZA JANE. Was at home in 1871, she is a servant in Margate in 1881 to the Fagg family. Eliza had a baby girl out of wedlock in 1871 and named her Victoria Hannah Caroline Goodbourn no father mentioned on the birth cert, she also had a daughter Florence Ada Goodbourn in 1880 both born in the Minster Workhouse again no father mentioned.

Eliza Jane married John Allingham in 1886 he was 22 years older than her. On the 1891 census Florence is shown as Goodbourn but on the ancestry info she is shown as Allingham. Her birth certificate confirms her as being Goodbourn.

Victoria married Charles Lovelock and in September 1890, and emigrated to Canada arriving on the 9/08/1907 on board the "City of Bombay" from Liverpool.

1890 married Charles Lovelock in Margate.

1891 census Charles Victoria on son Charles living Margate

1901 census still in Margate with children 1-6

1907 she emigrated to Canada with all children.

1911 Canadian census living Shulee, district of Cumberland, Nova Scotia, Canada

1930 American census Charles (father) is living with his son Frederick in New York.

Florence Ada married William Bernard Cooper in 1899.

1901 census shows her living in Fulham with her husband and daughter Norah Cooper age 3 months.

By 1911 the family were living at 476, Tilton Street, Fulham the census states the following.

William Cooper Head age 32 Travelling Showman from Swansea Wales.

Florence Wife age 31 born Birchington Kent.

Norah Rose daughter born 16/11/1900 Fulham died 1977 age 77.

William Bernard son born 1903 Fulham

Louisa Emily daughter born 1910 Fulham.

Henry F 1912 Hackney may have died in 1912 aged 0

THOMAS 1820 married Eliza Reynolds born c1824 on the 20/10/1845, they had three children.

Thomas was a gardener.

Ellen Elizabeth born 1847 who married James Edward Brockman in the September quarter of 1878

Frederick William born 1849 who married Ann Wooten Jan quarter of 1877

Thomas born 1851 who married Jane Pearce in 1872.

Eliza died and was interred in All Saints on the 27/04/1858 aged 34.

Thomas died and was interred in All Saints on the 1/11/1858 aged 38.

The three children were taken in by William born 1815 and Susanna, both parents having died.

ELLEN ELIZABETH AND JAMES EDWARD BROCKMAN DAUGHTER OF THOMAS 1820 AND ELIZA.

Ellen married in 1878 she and James he was a baker and had only one daughter – Lucy born 1879. Lucy married Ernest Frederick Pantony in 1903 GRO marriage ref. 2a 2186.

FREDERICK AND ANN NEE WOOTEN SON OF THOMAS AND ELIZA.

They had five children all girls.

Elizabeth Jane born 1881

Katie born 1879 and died 01/07/1894 aged 15.

Ellen born 1885 and died 26/02/1902 aged 17.

Anna born 1884 and died 25/04/1937 aged 53.

Eda Mary 1888 married Robert J. Colyer 1916 had one daughter Eda Mary 1920.

Robert was born 1892 in Margate and the son of Edwin born 1854 in Faversham and Eliza Ann Wells born 1858 in Margate who married in 1879 Edward was as baker confectioner with his own business, they also had servants. Robert was one of 5 children.

Katie, Ellen and Anna are buried together in Birchington cemetery

Census for Frederick

1851 With his parents Thomas and Eliza.

1861 With William and Susanna all three of Thomas and Eliza's children are there William is a master baker living at the Bakers Shop High Street.

1871 Frederick is now the baker still living at the bakers shop, William is now married to Ann and a gardener, Frederick is single.

1881 Now married he is living 1, Eden Villas, Margate Road, Birchington, a baker employing one man and one boy.

1891

1901 Still the a baker in The Square Birchington

1923 Frederick is interred in All Saints Birchington on 20/09/1923 he is said to be living in The Square at the time of his death.

Frederick was a baker, he was trained by, and took over the family business from his uncle, in 1891 Frederick is stated in Piggots as being a baker in Westgate, R.S.O. Birchington, the 1902 and 1913 Piggots he is still a baker in The Square, Birchington.

THOMAS AND JANE NEE PEARCE SON OF THOMAS AND ELIZA.

THOMAS married Jane Pearce born 1846, he was a blacksmith and dairyman employing 1 man and 1 boy. He lived in Canterbury Road, Birchington with his family.

They had ten children.

Ellen born 1875

Arthur Samuel born 1877 married Priscilla Jane Hadlow 1898. 1901 census shows Arthur in hospital in Canterbury and Priscilla at home in Birchington with their son Percival.

Clara A 1878 believed to have died in County Asylum Chartham Kent and interred in All Saints 07/02/1902.

Thomas William born 1879

Charles George born 1880 died 1881 aged 6 months

Alice O BORN 1883 *died April Quarter of 1977 aged 90 and single unconfirmed

May born 1885 *died June quarter of 1959 aged 75 and single unconfirmed

Jane born 1886 married either George Edwards or Charles G Willett Oct quarter 1911

Percy born 1888 joined the Royal Field Artillery Home Counties (Cinque Ports) 01/07/1909 states on Paper that he had been refused entry into the forces before as his chest measurement was too small, also states that he was in the 1st V B Buffs E.K. Reg for three years and left on completion of service.

In 1881 also living with them was Jane's mother also called Jane and born in 1817 in Wye Kent.

1891 Thomas and Jane are living in Birchington with all the children with the exception of Ellen.

1901 Thomas and Jane are still living in Thanet with Clara 23, May 16,, Jane 14, Percy 13 also there is Jane's mother Jane aged 85.

Thomas died in 1924 aged 72.

Jane Pearce died 1908 aged 91she was interred in All Saints on January 18th 1908

MARY Ann 1822 she is believed to have stayed single, and is shown as a servant to the Pointon family in Margate, Kent in 1861.

SARAH 1826 died in 1846 aged 20 and is buried in All Saints churchyard.

Census**

1841 At home with parents

1849 married Isabella Buchanan 30th December 1849 at St. Mary's Stratford. (London)

1851 living with Isabella their daughter Mary Ann born December 1850 BMD ref. 2 353, aged 5 months in Orchard Terrace, Devons Lane, Bromley by Bow Middlesex (East London). Isabella was the daughter of Arthur Charles Buchanan.

1861 Now living in 31, Victoria Street, Bristol, Gloucestershire, with Mary Ann born 1850 Horace born 1857 in St Luke's Finsbury Middlesex BMD ref. 1b 524 and Isabella born June 1859 in Bristol BMD 6a 33 George is a Silk Hat finisher.

1866 death of Horace William aged 11 in Clifton Gloucestershire

1871 census Isabella married William Priest born 1814 in 1863 at Clifton. William already had two children John born 1851 and William born 1853, Isabella and William had two children of their own Elizabeth 1864 and Eliza 1865, daughter Isabella is with them aged 13.

1881 Isabella and William Priest are living 1, Mills Place Bristol Temple. Isabella is a tailoress and William is a boat builder with them are Elizabeth now aged 17 and a visitor Edward Collier aged 4, no other relationship stated, Isabella (daughter) has now left home and is a servant to Richard W Johnson and his family in Clifton.

1891 William is shown now a widower Isabella dying in 1889 aged 57. Edward Collier is still there.

William Priest's first wife was Maria Williams she was born 1816, they married 22//01/1837 in Bristol.

1841 census shows them in Bristol with daughter Maria Ann aged 3 months.

1861 census shows them with the children Amelia 1846, Maria Ann 1848, Sophia 1851 and William 1853.

Maria died 1862 aged 46

William died in 1892 aged 78.

As yet I have not been able to trace a death for George, but there is a death in 1860 of George Godfrey Clifton Glous. July quarter this may be him with name transcribed incorrectly.
