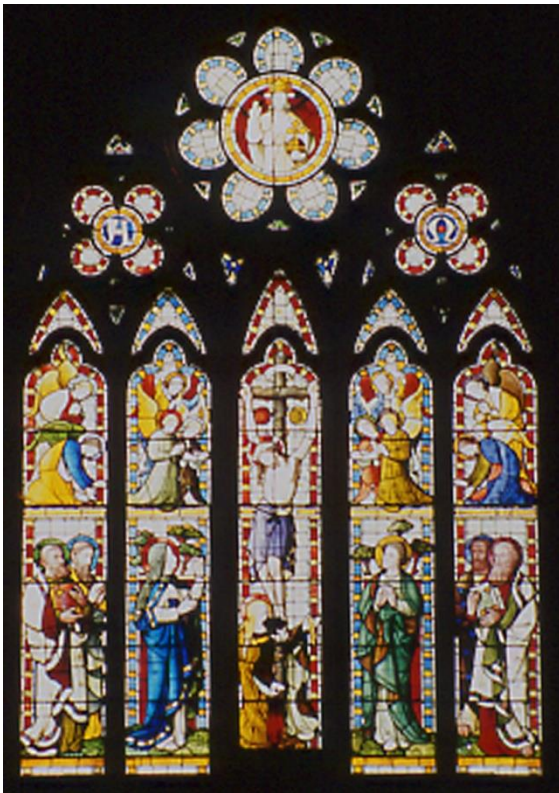


East & West Windows in All Saints
June 1873 – Keble's Gazette

During the past week two beautiful coloured glass windows have been placed in the Parish Church, the East window being raised by public subscriptions and the West being put in at the expense of Thomas Gray, Esq., of Birchington Hall in memory of several members of his family.

The windows were dedicated on Whit Sunday, 1st June 1873. The colours in the East window are most skilfully and harmoniously blended, especially with regard to the light shed on the chancel in the Church. The entire cost of the window was £180.

The stained glass in both windows was the work of Messrs Lavers, Barrand and Westlake of Endell Street, Bloomsbury.
