

ROSSETTI BUNGALOW

Built c. 1878 by John Seddon architect of Tower Bungalows

Seddon lent the bungalow to Hall Caine for the use of Dante Gabriel Rossetti, Feb – April 1882. Caine was a close friend of Rossetti and a great help to him after his stroke in the autumn of 1881.

Rossetti died there 9th April 1882

After his death the bungalow, originally known as 'Westcliffe', was renamed 'Rossetti Bungalow' in his honour.
